

The regular meeting of the Truman City Council was held March 7, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Brownlee.

#### 1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Mosloski to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held February 16, 2016. All yeas - carried.

A motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the minutes of the special meeting (work session) held February 22, 2016. All yeas

#### 2. PRAIRIELAND SOLID WASTE - CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT RENEWAL

Prairieland Solid Waste Director Billeye Rabbe presented information on the operation of the plant during 2015. They now have nine full-time employees and have just hired a new part-time office person. They have a balanced budget. They are using a vegetation management service to maintain growth around the buildings. They are finishing up on the \$200,000 reconstruction project on the refining building (now storage building) on the south side of the property. Rabbe went through the totals for the household hazardous waste program and she also stated the recycling program is going well.

A motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the annual renewal of the conditional use permit for the Prairieland Solid Waste facility. All yeas - carried.

#### 3. SHIP - ACTIVE LIVING UPDATE

Truman Active Living committee member Vickie Lewis was present. She said that they are trying to set up a Bike Rodeo for young students at the school. They also want to do a walk and ride to school that same day. They are tentatively looking at May 4 for these events. They are looking for business donations for bike helmets.

The committee is also looking at volunteer adult crossing guards at the two Ciro Street crossings and at the Highway 15 crossing for kids walking to school in the mornings. They have the safety vests but they need to purchase the crossing poles. Kirsten Bressler will be talking to the school about this program.

#### 4. FRONT YARD PARKING - ZONING RECOMMENDATION

Reviewed the recommendation from the planning & zoning commission on changes to the zoning code for front yard parking.

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Mosloski to hold a public hearing on April 4, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. for proposed changes to the zoning code for front yard parking. All yeas - carried.
