

The regular meeting of the Truman City Council was held June 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-tem Ebert.

#### 1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Mosloski to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held May 16, 2016 and the minutes of the work session held May 16, 2016. All yeas - carried.

#### 2. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF TRUMAN ORDINANCE NO. 2015-1 AMENDING PREVIOUS RURAL AND URBAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF TRUMAN - ORDINANCE #2016-2

A public hearing was held on the proposed Rural Service District ordinance amendment. City Clerk Monte Rohman presented the information on the updated ratio of benefits for agricultural land in the city limits. The current ratio is 24% and the proposed ratio for 2017 is 23%. Also reviewed information on ratios and tax rates for rural service districts in the other Martin County communities. Clerk Rohman and city attorney Jim Wilson had toured the rural service district and found no changes in the parcels that are eligible for the benefits.

Land owner Arnie Bentz was present and he did not have any issues. Clerk Rohman had met with him last week and went over everything with him.

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Hendricksen to offer Ordinance #2016-2 for the Rural Service District. All yeas - carried.

#### 3. NEW FIREFIGHTERS

Fire Chief Dave Bentz recommended hiring two new firefighters. There are currently two openings on the department.

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Bressler to hire Brady Selnes and Matt Lange as Truman firefighters. All yeas - carried.

#### 4. RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES FOR 2016 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS - RESOLUTION #2016-3

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Hendricksen to approve Resolution #2016-3 appointing the following election judges for 2016 and setting the pay rate at \$9.50 per hour:

#### 5. LIGHTING AT MUNICIPAL BUILDING

City Clerk Monte Rohman presented information on replacing some of the current T-12 lighting in the Municipal Building with T-8 lighting for energy efficiency. This project was budgeted for.

A motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Hendricksen to approve a quote of \$2,207 from G & D Electric to replace lighting in the Municipal Building. All yeas - carried.

#### 6. PAY REQUEST - PHASE III STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Upon recommendation of the city engineer, a motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Mosloski to approve Pay Request #9 to Holtmeier Construction in the amount of \$12,176.15 for the Phase III Storm Sewer Improvement Project. All yeas - carried.

#### 7. BOULEVARD TREES - ANGELA TERRY

Upon request, a motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Mosloski to grant permission to Angela Terry to remove trees from the boulevard at 410 East Ciro Street. All yeas - carried.

8. PARK & RECREATION LABOR RATE

Upon recommendation from City Clerk Monte Rohman, a motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Hendricksen to raise the pay rate to \$8.00 per hour for part-time park and recreation employees. All yeas - carried.

9. CITY CLAIMS

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Bressler to approve the city claims:

Will use park and recreation seasonal employees to help do mowing for the street department to allow street staff to work on other duties for the summer.
