

The regular meeting of the Truman City Council was held June 20, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Brownlee.

1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Ebert to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held June 6, 2016. All yeas - carried.

2. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF TRUMAN ORDINANCE NO. 2015-1 AMENDING PREVIOUS RURAL AND URBAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF TRUMAN - ORDINANCE #2016-2

A motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Hendricksen to adopt Ordinance #2016-2 for the Rural Service District. All yeas - carried.

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Bressler to approve the summary version of Ordinance #2016-2 for official publication. All yeas - carried.

3. CEMETERY - TREE TRIMMING

Cemetery Commissioner Faith Clow was present to discuss the need to do tree trimming at the city cemetery. She was directed to get a couple quotes to do this work. After the meeting most of the city council toured the cemetery to see what needed to be done there.

4. CITIZENS CONCERNED ABOUT STORM WATER PONDING

Sherry and Tom Hansen were present to express their concern about how the storm water ponded around their house during the Friday night large rainfall event. The fire department came there twice to look at the situation and then left. They wanted the fire department to pump the water to the street west of their house to help take the ponding down. Councilor Ebert said he was there that night and said the fire department was concerned about possibly causing flooding issues on the next street if they did that.

Decided to do some televising of storm sewer lines in the areas that had major ponding during that large rain event (4-7 inches). Also will ask utility commission to do sump pump inspections in all homes to see that they are discharging to the storm sewer and not the sanitary sewer.

5. MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT

City Clerk Monte Rohman presented the May financial statements and went over some of the line items.

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Mosloski to approve the May, 2016 monthly city financial statements. All yeas - carried.

6. CITY CLAIMS

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the city claims:

General Account #34871-34916 \$92,955.70

All yeas - carried. Councilor Mosloski abstained on his claim and Councilor Ebert abstain on his claim and on the Superior Contracting Services claims.

7. REGION 9 CONTRACT FOR SERVICES - ACTIVE LIVING PLANNING

A motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Ebert to approve the contract for services with Region 9 to do the active living planning strategy. All yeas - carried. The costs will be covered by a grant.

8. COMMUNITY BUILDING WINDOW

Two quotes were received to replace the cracked window at the community building.

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Ebert to accept the \$453.91 quote from BoeKett Building Supply for a new window at the Truman Community Building. All yeas - carried.

Will talk to a local contractor about installing it.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

Will meet with city engineer to review new grass and sod at Graf Park and also to discuss the new drains placed there.

Street department will be directed to have the alleys graded and new gravel added where needed.

10. ADJOURN
