

The regular meeting of the Truman City Council was held August 15, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Brownlee.

#### 1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held August 1, 2016. All yeas - carried.

#### 2. PUBLIC HEARING - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF TRUMAN ZONING ORDINANCE SECTION 2, APPLICATION OF DISTRICT REGULATIONS BY ADDING SECTION 2.8 TO OPT OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES 462.3593, TEMPORARY FAMILY HEALTH CARE DWELLINGS - ORDINANCE #2016-3

Opened the public hearing to public comment.

There being no opposition, a motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Ebert to offer Ordinance #2016-3 to opt out of the State law on temporary family health care dwellings. All yeas - carried.

Councilor Bressler arrived.

#### 3. MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT

City Clerk Monte Rohman present the July, 2016 city financial report and went over some of the line items.

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Ebert to approve the July, 2016 financial statements as presented. All yeas - carried.

#### 4. CITY CLAIMS

A motion was made by Bressler, seconded by Ebert to approve the city claims:

#### 5. SQUAD CAR TIRES

Upon recommendation from the police chief, a motion was made by Ebert, seconded by Hendricksen to purchase four new tires for the 2015 squad car for the State bid price of \$589.72. All yeas - carried.

#### 6. MISCELLANEOUS

Discussed storm sewer maintenance. Three residents were present to inquire about present maintenance and future improvements. The city engineer will present his report in September regarding future storm sewer improvement ideas along with costs. Street Superintendent John Bosshart reported that a blockage on Central Avenue had been cleaned out and that further jetting of sewers will be done when the tractor is fixed.

Council set a deadline for Friday for a State plumbing permit application to be submitted for the new bathroom/showers to be completed at the pool.

Councilor Hendricksen discussed proposed utility rate increases for 2017 and showed a list of improvements need in each utility department.

The proposed 2017 city budget was reviewed. Discussed the proposed capital outlay items and some additional items were discussed. The budget will be reviewed and discussed for two more meetings.

Police Chief Justin Jobe discussed the idea of requiring house numbers on all buildings to help emergency services personnel respond quicker to emergencies.

Discussed need for concrete pad for the new bike rack so it can be bolted down.

Councilor Mosloski arrived.
