

The regular meeting of the Truman City Council was held October 5, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Brownlee.

1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held September 21, 2015. All yeas - carried.

2. POLICE REPORT

Councilor Bressler arrived.

Police Chief Justin Jobe presented the quarterly police report. He reported that the calls for service are way ahead of last year. The department just completed the TZD program for the DWI wave and will be doing a seatbelt wave this month. Jobe will be attending a TZD conference in St. Cloud this month. Jobe discussed the new in-car computers that will be installed later this year that a grant will reimburse half the costs.

3. MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH ST. JAMES

After review and approval by the fire department and ambulance service, a motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Bressler to approve the Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of St. James. All yeas - carried.

4. PAY REQUEST #6 - PHASE III STORM SEWER PROJECT

Upon recommendation from the city engineer, a motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Bressler to approve Pay Request #6 in the amount of \$230,412.14 to Holtmeier Construction for work completed on the Phase III Storm Sewer Improvement Project. All yeas - carried.
