1. MINUTES

A motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Hendricksen to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held October 5, 2015. All yeas - carried.

2. AMBULANCE MONITORS PURCHASED

EMT's Josh Kitzerow, Mona Weihe and Lori Rusert were present to give an update on a grant they received to purchase new X-series monitors for the department. Zoll would trade in one of our Lifepak Fisio E-series units and one Zoll unit even up for a new Zoll X-series unit. They would also sell us a second unit for around \$24,500. The department would then sell the other E-series unit for \$4,000 to \$5,000 to another department.

A motion was made by Hendricksen, seconded by Ebert to purchase two X-series monitors from Zoll with the grant. All yeas - carried.
