A special meeting of the Truman City Council was held October 24, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Brownlee.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss purchasing a used jetter/vacuum truck for cleaning sewers.

1. JETTER/VACUUM TRUCK PURCHASE

Street Superintendent John Bosshart and public utilities representatives Gary Greenwald and Judi Davis were present to discuss the quote from MacQueen Equipment for the purchase of a used jetter/vacuum truck for cleaning storm and sanitary sewers. MacQueen will send a representative down soon to show staff how to use the various sized nozzles. Bosshart had all his questions and concerns answered last week by salesman Kevin Fischer and recommends purchasing the unit. Greenwald said the camera system that Fischer showed the staff wasn't what they are looking for and he recommended waiting until next year to purchase a real time camera system. Councilor Mosloski asked if MacQueen will stand behind the unit next spring when the unit first gets used. Greenwald said the PUC will be jetting sanitary sewers yet this fall. Discussed selling the old jetter and vac. The old vac doesn't have much value left. Bosshart will check into selling the old units.

A motion was made by Mosloski, seconded by Hendricksen to purchase a 1993 Guzzler B26680 jetter/vacuum truck from MacQueen Equipment for \$57,006 with the costs split jointly with Truman Public Utilities. All yeas – carried.

The truck is subject to the State vehicle excise tax when the unit is licensed later.
