Truman City Council Minutes August 4, 2022

A Special Meeting was duly held at the Municipal Building in the fire department meeting room on the 4th day of August, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Terry Bentele, Councilor Jake Ebert, Councilor Brandon Mosloski, and Councilor Patty Truax.

Absent: Councilor Brian Nickerson.

Staff present: Street Department Wayne Wiederhoeft, City Clerk/Treasurer Melissa Sirovy.

Mayor Terry Bentele presided over the meeting, beginning at 5:30 p.m.

The special meeting was called to order to discuss the Bau property and the pool.

Pool Business

Wayne Wiederhoeft advised the council the staining at the pool did not come off with the pressure washer so the pool will need to be closed for the season. In the future, the pool won't be filled for a few days after hydrants are flushed to help prevent stains from developing. The pool was already scheduled to be cleaned and painted next spring, so it will be ready for the 2023 season. Discussion took place regarding how to refund those who paid for season passes and aerobics. Motion made by Mosloski, seconded by Ebert to offer a cash refund for 4 weeks out of a 13-week season for passes and aerobics, or alternatively, half off the cost of the same kind of pass in 2023. All ayes — motion carried. Those who paid for swimming lessons that had to be canceled will receive a full refund. Lifeguards will be offered other city work for the remainder of their seasonal position at the same rate of pay if they are interested.

Bau Property

Bids for cleanup of the Bau property were reviewed. Beemer Companies bid \$82,000, S & J Excavating bid \$162,000, and Rosburg Construction bid \$40,000. Motion made by Mosloski, seconded by Truax to accept the bid from Rosburg Construction. All ayes – motion carried. Councilor Truax agreed to contact Rosburg to discuss the work and their bid. There was concern about their bid being so much lower than the others.

Motion made by Ebert, seconded by Truax to adjourn. All ayes – motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
