Truman City Council Minutes October 15, 2023

An Emergency Meeting was duly held at the Municipal Building on the 15th day of October, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Jacob Ebert, Councilors Chris Mosloski and Ron Kelley,

Absent: Councilors Patty Truax and Brian Nickerson.

Also Present: Representatives from Westford and Nashville Townships, Fire Chief Dave Bentz, Brandon Mosloski, Kaleena Wiens, Josh Kitzerow, and other members of the Fire Department.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the purchase of a used rescue truck from the City of Shakopee.

Consideration was given to the purchase of a 2007 Rosenbauer rescue truck with 10,000 miles on it to replace the 1991 rescue truck. At \$180,000, it is less than other trucks the department has found for sale. It comes with extra equipment, but a cascade system would be needed. If the cost is split between the city and townships, at \$180,000 it would cost townships about \$1139 per section, or at \$200,000 about \$1266. The old rescue would be sold and that revenue would be put back into the truck fund. Delivery would be anticipated in December.

Following discussion, the township officials in attendance approved of the city making an offer on the truck. Motion made by Kelley, seconded by Mosloski to approve purchase of the truck from the City of Shakopee for up to \$200,000. All ayes – motion carried.

Motion made by Mosloski, seconded by Kelley to adjourn. All ayes - motion carried.
