Hendricksen would like to see the tennis courts repurposed to pickle ball courts. Ebert added that it would be nice to also have a basketball court. Suggesting that when the new courts are installed to also install rods so an ice-skating rink can be assembled in the winter months. Hendricksen suggested applying for grants for this project.

Nickerson would like to see improvements to the campground. Upgrading the water and electric are a necessity to draw in larger campers. He also suggested planting of trees and adding fill to allow for more camping spots. Nickerson added that he thought there was left over paint that could be used to paint the picnic tables and sheds. It was suggested to ask SHIP if they would be interested in helping paint.

Ebert would like to see money allocated to the pool, Truman Days and future water/sewer improvements.

Mosloski would like to see improvements to the pool as well as additions such another slide, zero depth/splash pad. He suggested expanding the campground and downtown revitalization. He suggested community building renovations such as new cupboards and roof modifications.
